Free and fair elections are the foundation of a healthy democracy. State Election Commission is the Constitutional body responsible for conducting and supervising elections to local bodies in the State. The general election in 46 urban local bodies, out of 187 urban local bodies, comprising 6 Municipal Corporations, 18 Municipal Councils and 22 Nagar palikas comprising 1696 wards were held in November, 2014 .


Election for remaining 141 urban local bodies will be held after completion of their due period of five years.

The Commission has prepared a detailed report of these elections held in November, 2014.
